Cake Stall

Each year we run a fantastic cake and sweet stall which is stocked with donated homemade goods provided by our wonderful school families – we ask that each child provides a homemade cake or cupcakes (max two cakes per family), and make two bags of homemade sweets, such as fudge, coconut ice etc.

The key to the success of the cake stall is that we sell homemade goods.

Next week, your child will bring home a cake box, and an envelope containing two sweet bags, ribbon, labels and instructions.

There is also a cake decorating competition! The best-decorated cake or cupcakes will be awarded 1st, 2nd and 3rd places. Adult and children's entrants will be judged separately this year.

- For the competition entry, please label the cake so that we know whether it was created by a child or adult (child name, class No. and 'child' or 'adult').

- Please also ensure you label your cake with the cake flavour (e.g. chocolate, banana etc), and any specific dietary information (e.g. gluten or dairy-free).

This year's cake competition theme is "**RURAL LIFE**". So get creative and have fun! Cakes and sweets are to be delivered to Room 8 on Friday 1st Nov, between 8.30-9 am and 3-6 pm.
